# Over \$5,000 in Prize Money

- 4) All pledges over \$20.00 will be tax-receipted unless otherwise requested.
- 5) The top 3 teams with the lowest gross scores will receive the opportunity to direct the United Way to designate their prize amounts to the Registered Charity of their choice.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> - \$2,000
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$1,500
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$1,000
- 6) As well as the top 3 teams winning the prize money, the team that raises the most in pledges will have the opportunity to designate their pledges to the registered charity of their choice and also a team randomly drawn will also have the opportunity to designate their pledges to the charity of their choice.
- 7) Teams should decide on their charity of choice prior to the event in anticipation of winning.
- 8) Teams will provide their own attire and propaganda.
- 9) Deadline for registration of teams is, September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2001.
